

Context, Background of SIP and UHV in SIP

The purpose of education is to prepare the student to live a fulfilling life. In the draft NEP 2019, the purpose is articulated as “education for the development of full human potential and a just and equitable society”. It may also be put as “education for the well-being of all”.

For this to happen, it is essential to understand the meaning of “fulfilling life”, “full human potential”, “just and equitable society” and “well-being of all”. When these meanings, understanding or values guide the actions, then the cherished purpose or goals may be realized.

However, when these values are not guiding the actions; and some other assumed values are influencing the actions, then the outcomes may be quite different – it is not definite whether they will be desirable or otherwise. That is the indefiniteness we see all around. Education has become skill biased with the value aspect almost missing.

In an effort to bring in the value aspect, AICTE has taken the initiative to include Universal Human Values (UHV) for the newly joined engineering aspirants. The program is scheduled for 21 days comprising the Universal human values, co-curricular activities, departmental visits, and visits to nearest heritage places, industries etc.,

The SIP is intended as a welcoming orientation for incoming students:

1. To become familiar with the ethos and culture of the new surroundings
2. To develop bonds with peers, seniors, faculty and staff
3. To provide an exposure to a holistic vision of life
(based on larger national and human good; or the well-being of all), Develop awareness, sensitivity and understanding of the Self---family---Society---Nation---International---Entire Nature
4. To develop a healthy lifestyle and ethical professional discipline
5. To connect and appreciate the diversity of cultures
6. To overcome weaknesses in some essential professional skills to be ready for higher study (only for those who need)

The UHV module is intended to address goal #2 (above) by starting a process of self-inquiry, to develop clarity on life-goals and relationship. At the minimum, it should help the student to see the need for developing a holistic perspective of life. It is also intended to begin to guide all other activities, particularly during the SIP.

7. Physical Health and related activities, Importance of yoga/meditation/physical exercise to keep fit.
8. Arts and Culture
9. Language proficiency modules
10. Literary Activities- writing its summary, and possibly, debating, enacting a play, etc

You are hereby informed to conduct revision classes for 1st semester B.E./B.Tech./B.Arch./B.Plan., students for the subjects/practicals, whose examinations are yet to be conducted.

You are hereby directed to bring the same to the notice of all concerned and follow them scrupulously. All the Institutes must submit a compliance report in this regards to undersigned. Non-compliance and casual approach by the Institute in implementing above programme will be viewed very seriously.

Speaker: Dr, Gorbal, Professor, Dept. of CSE, ATMECE



In his conclusion statement sir advised all the students to be open and think out of the box. Also said students should feed right things to their senses so that they can apply their knowledge and keep their mind creative.


Day 3: 05 May 2021


Day 4: 06 MAY 2021

Figure: Live demonstration of meditation




Figure: Live demonstration of Pranayam

Session 2: Special Lecture Series


Topic: Outcome based Education


Day 6: 10 MAY 2021
